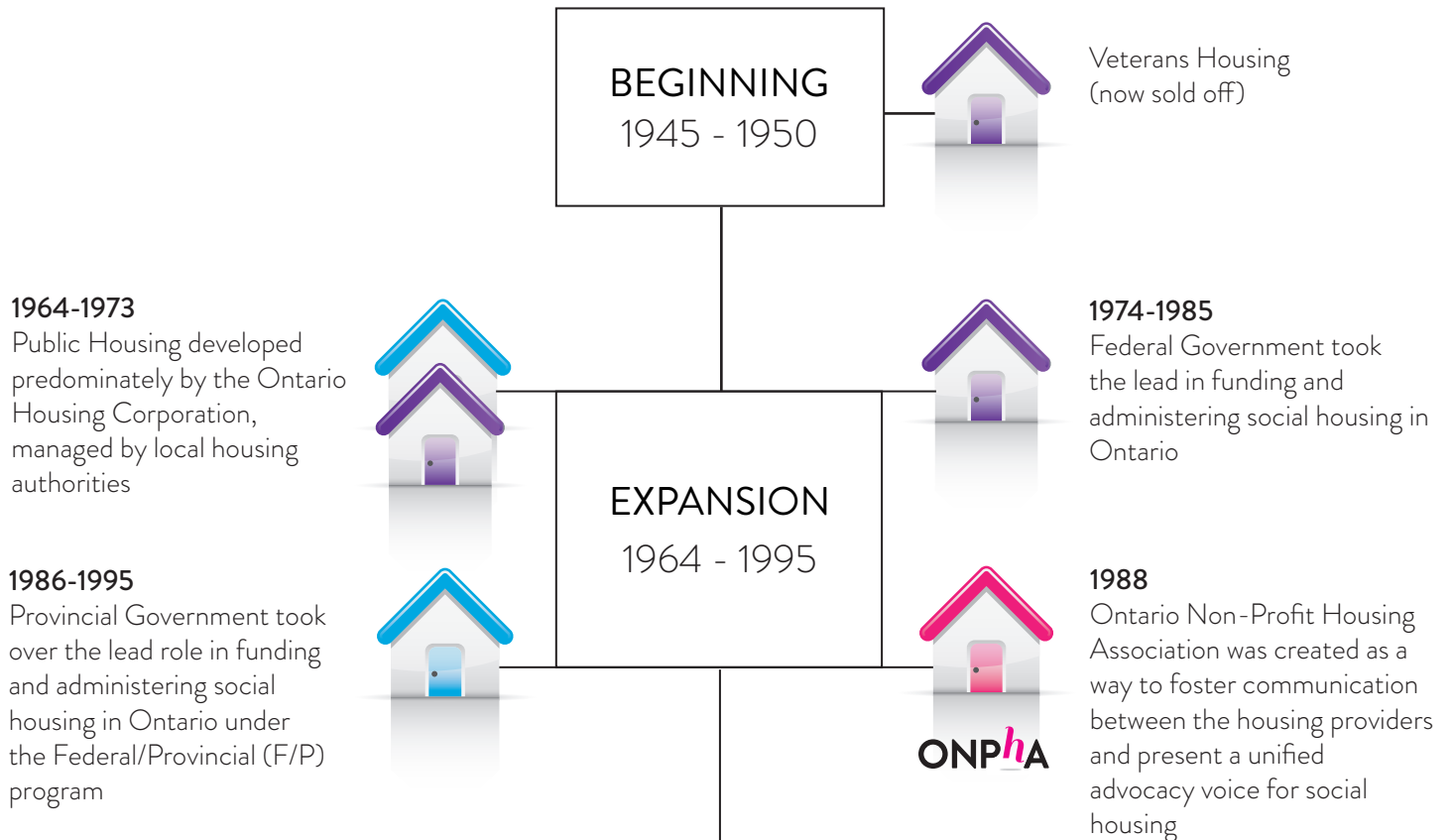


A HISTORY OF *Non-Profit Housing* IN ONTARIO 1945 - 2017

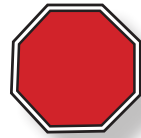


Timeline last updated: June 2017

1995
First extended period without government funding for new affordable housing in 50 years. Virtually no non-profit housing was developed during this time.



DEVOLUTION
1996 - 2002



1999
Federal Government off-loaded administration and funding of social housing to Ontario through the signing of the Canada-Ontario Social Housing Agreement

2001 - 2002
Province devolves funding and administration of existing social housing to 47 Service Managers but keeps responsibility for supportive housing



2002-2016
Federal Government re-establishes its role. Federal and Provincial Governments invest small amount of funds back into social housing through Investment in Affordable Housing and Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative (CHPI)



CONSTRAINT
2002 - 2016



2005 - 2016
Service Managers introduce and fund their own programs, including rent supplements, housing allowances, new development and capital repair

2009 - 2015
Various renovation and retrofit funding programs available to address energy upgrades and building repairs



2011 & 2016
Ontario's Long-Term Affordable Housing Strategy (LTAHS) is created in 2011 and updated in 2016

2016
Province launches consultation on a Modernized Housing Framework

2016-2017



2017
Federal budget committed \$11.2B over 11 years towards forthcoming National Housing Strategy
